October 1 - 13, 2010

We will be undertaking several distinctive painting projects in the historic Castello di Casigliano, a 16th century castle with a history of intrigue and important guests. Set in the Umbrian hillside, the magical views are matched by the warm hospitality of our hosts.

Besides our delightful accommodations in Umbria, we will also be visiting Rome, local medieval hill towns, and will end our trip with two and a half days in Florence. There, we will stay at the beautiful Fattoria di Maiano, which is perched on the hills just above Florence. The Maiano was the site of one of our previous trips to Italy in 2007.

Our Itinerary includes: *subject to slight changes*

Friday October 1

Depart from US on overnight flight to Rome

Saturday October 2

Arrive in Rome early morning (plan your flight to arrive by 9am).

Take bus to Castello di Casigliano with a stop at a local grocery store to purchase wine, drinks and food for your apartment. (All apartments include kitchen facilities)

Arrive mid-afternoon at Castello di Casigliano. Free afternoon to unpack, socialize and explore!

Grand welcome dinner for the group in the Castello dining room.

Sunday October 3

Late breakfast @ 9am followed by a private tour of the Castello with our host, Romano Crispoldi.

Take bus to a winery near Montefalco for a group lunch and wine tasting. Additional time in Montefalco.

Possible option: Stop on way home in Todi to visit churches, shop, and scope out restaurants to come back to Monday night.

Friday October 8

Painting Day (breakfast and gourmet lunch included)

Celebratory evening party at the Castello with champagne and cake in your honor.

Saturday October 9

Bus leaves at 10am for Rome after breakfast at the Castello. Drop off at various points in Rome (Vatican/Forum/Borghese Gardens/Termini Station).

You are free to make your own plans for sightseeing, lunch and dinner on this day. At a later date, we will be provided suggestions and resources if you need help deciding what to do and see!

Return on bus to Castello from Termini Station @ 11pm

Sunday October 10

Bus leaves at 10am for Florence after breakfast at the Castello.

Stop in Montepulciano on the way for lunch and sightseeing on your own for 3 hours

(We can possibly arrange a visit for the group at the Pulcino tasting store in Montepulciano. Quick stop at grocery store on the way. Arrive to Maiano by 4pm

Dinner on your own at the restaurant at the Maiano or taxi into Florence for dinner.

Free day in Florence. Breakfast, lunch, dinner on your own.

*We will attempt to arrange a private tour of the Maiano estate on this with the owner of both the Castello di Casigliano and the Fattoria di Maino, the Contessa Miari Fulcis
